As June Tenor of all the White Lands  
Wilmington, Vermont. & other Rights belonging  
to the Society of Sarah Church of Impoverish  
in the County of Benning & now in the possession  
of Mr John Wiley Foster there & on his  
decease. The 14th Day of June in the year of our  
Lord 1780.

Imprisoned the Site of the Society. The Parsonage  
House three Barns with three Stables two gardens  
& an Outhouse & ~~the~~ Cow & Horse.

Item Two hundred & sixty five Aers of Land, (about  
miles) now in the possession of Peter Harmon  
Colonel Harmon of Ferris Station.

Item There is also within the said Parish a Little  
Harmon belonging to the Society, to which several  
Cops hold Grants & several of Towns

Item The said Society is proprietor of the School of  
the Village of Ferris, now in the possession of the  
Wardens & Trustees of Ferris College & Ferris  
in the Parish of Ferris & of several other  
in the said Parish. They are proprietor of the  
School now in the possession of the  
Wardens & Trustees of Ferris College & Ferris
