

Tingewick Deaths from Tingewick Historical Society Archives

- Page 9, 1608, Erasmus Williams Rector of Tingewick died.
- Page 10 1712 24th October, Richard Crichton buried in Churchyard. He was robbed and murdered. Also recorded in the Historical Notes Folder. He was aged 17 years.

Buckingham Express 1872 20th January

- January 14th. At Tingewick, James Harvey, aged 73. He was carried to the grave by the ringers, having been a ringer upwards of 55 years.
- January 16th. At Tingewick, the wife of the late Mr. T. Howse.

Buckingham Express 1872 17th February

- February 25th, at Tingewick, Mr. Thomas Cave, Butcher, aged 75 years
- February 25th, at Tingewick, Alice, widow of the late Mr. James Grey, blacksmith, aged 77 years.

Buckingham Express 1872 March 23rd

- March 23rd, at Tingewick, Mr. Richard Steeden aged 70 years.
- March 27th, at Hillesden, Ann, wife of Mr. William Stuchbury, aged 56 years.

Buckingham Express 1872 25th May

- May 20th, at Tingewick, Mr. John Petty, aged 58 years.

Buckingham Express 1872 31st August

- August 27, at Tingewick, Elizabeth widow of the late Mr. George Cumings, of Buckingham, aged 68 years.

Buckingham Express 1872

- September 27, at Tingewick, Mr. John Butcher, aged 53 years
- October 6, at Tingewick, Mr. Richard Petty, aged 33 years.
- November 1, at Tingewick, Mary the wife of Mr. J. Longstaffe, Crown Inn, aged 66 years.
- November 2, at Tingewick, Stephen the son of Mr. Henry Bloxham, aged 3 years.

Buckingham Express 1872 7th December

- *November 23, at Union Workhouse, Sarah Keys, aged 76 years. ?? from Tingewick ?*
- November 30 at Tingewick, Eliza, the wife of Mr. Henry Collinridge aged 32 years.

Buckingham Express :-
1873

- 10th May. Mr. Worvill member of church choir buried in churchyard

1874

- 14th February Suicide of John Berry (Long article)

- 13th June. Interment in Churchyard of Geo Hitchcock aged 21 years.

1876

- October 28th, Obituary, Death of Mrs. Nelson. Both Tingewick and Buckingham sustained severe loss. Generous benefactor to the poor especially of Tingewick.
- November 11th. Obituary, Death of Geo. Nelson (Solicitor)
Long obituary. Died 15 days after wife. Town Clerk of Buckingham for nearly 27 years. Died at Tingewick, feeling unwell whilst awaiting his carriage to take him to Buckingham.

1877

- January 27th. Inquest. At Royal Oak on the body of Will Parkins, 71, Parish Clerk. Found drowned in ditch between West Wood Riding and The Narrows.
Verdict – giddy and accidentally drowned.
- May 5th. Annie Painter (42) widow of the late Geo. Painter on May 1st at “The Mount”

1878

- Feb. 9th. Thos. Painter, Guardian of the Parish of Tingewick. Also Chairman of Buckingham Poor Law Board of Guardians. Manager, Secretary of The Crown Friendly Society. Aged 71.
- April 13th. Inquest at The Crown on Jas. Bloxham, 10 weeks old. Verdict – accidentally suffocated

1882

- 10th February. Geo. Markham muffled peal (presumably buried in churchyard)

1884

- 2nd. August. Death of Jonathan Arnott – 73 years
Richard Greaves, 19 years.
